	As the US Nationals took place in the tunnel shortly before, this would have been a good event to test another camera in advance and not do it at the last minute.  The shortening of the schedule could not be fully understood because we were not under any time pressure. Due to the time it took to provide the videos, the time for judging was very short, so that results were not always published before the next round.  I would recommend in the future to involve all parties before changing the schedule, so that consequences can be shown at an early phase and do not create frustration afterwards.
Rule Changes – Proposals:	Due to the number of teams, a reduced number of judges was discussed in advance.  Unfortunately, I could not find a value when such an check must be initiated by the CJ.  It is only described from which number of teams the number of judges must be increased.  Perhaps such a value could be added to the same table in SC5 4.6 or the CJ handbook.
Personal Remarks:	The competition went very well.  Many thanks for the great support even before the competition.  Thanks to the Organizer, FAI Controller, Jury, IT Support, Volunteers, and Judges for their hard work.  The great teamwork made my job easy.
