CHIEF JUDGE'S STANDARD REPORT

Competition:	World Indoor Skydiving Championships 2025		
Event:	Artistic Events Solo Freestyle Open and Junior.		
Location:	Charleroi, Belgium

Panel of Judges:	Nina Engel (EJ-Open), Bryce Witcher (EJ-Junior), Thi Bich Van Ha, Enbar Rosen, Robert Wielgoss, Ratul (Rai) Ahmad.		
Scoring Equipment Used:	InTime Scoring, Before the competition I had a Video call With Dirk for the last questions and explanation. It worked perfect.		
Details of the Judges Work: (including judging statistics)	We had 2 Zoom Sessions before the competition as part of the Judges conference. There we worked on the compulsories, Execution deductions and presentation in compulsory routines. So we could concentrate on the Initial Technical Scores in the Judges conference on site.		
	Al the competitors delivered there free routine video on time most of them with the routine description form. (Some of them send in their form later, but still before the start of the competition.)		
	We had 24 open (16 NAC's) and 12 (10 NAC's) Junior competitors. One of the Open competitors had to cancel due to injury.		
	With the videos of the free routines for the initial technical score and the competition we judged 212 routines.		
	2 competitors where offered a reflight, only 1 did the reflight.		
	There was also a case of abort during the pre-flight choreography before entering the flight chamber, when the competitor realized that the strap of his helmet was undone. The competitor started the routine again.		
Recommendations for	Thanks to the organizers for the hospitality.		
Organisers:	We had a judges room where the organizer arranged things we needed when it was asked for. Everything worked before the competition started.		
	The Intime scoring computers were also in the Freestyle Judges room. Both Judges panels entered their scores in there.		
	In the beginning the Jury and FAI controller were also in the same room as the freestyle judges, but this was changed before the competition so we would not disturb each other.		
	Transportation from and to pick-up points was not arranged Judges received an email/message one day in advance to arrange a Flibco bus to Charleroi airport themselves.

	In retrospect I did miss the assistant to the Chief judge at other times, especially arranging the transport of the judges to and from the tunnel because there were 2 panels of different disciplines that had to be in the tunnel at different times. And they were also working live against each other and therefore could not be disturbed. This did not make communication about this any easier.
Rule Changes – Proposals:	We only had 25 min. for a competitors meeting, so there was not a lot of time. We did manage to have some highlights on paper. We have decided together with the competitors that we will organize a Zoom meeting in the near future to go into this some more.
Personal Remarks:	This was my first time serving as chief judge, and I learned a great deal from the experience. There are aspects I would approach differently if given another opportunity (for example, not having an assistant to the chief judge). However, there are certainly things I would do in the same manner again (such as the preparation with the videos on Google Drive).
